



### Advance Passenger Information

US legislation, from 4th October 2005, requires all passengers entering the United States to provide details of their address whilst in the US.

Please note that failure to provide this information could result in boarding being refused, delays on your flight departure, and delays on arrival in the US. Heavy fines can also be levied against individuals.
