## London City airport to Reopen

London City airport has announced it is planning to restart commercial operations from the end of June, with further details including which airlines will resume flights due to be released soon.

In addition, it is partnering with Crowd-Vision to deploy technology that will detect areas in the terminal where there is a high concentration of passengers so people can be directed to quieter areas for social distancing purposes.

## Virgin Atlantic returning to the sky!

As countries around the world start to relax travel restrictions, we wanted to let you know of Virgin Atlantic's plan to restart flying travellers with services from London Heathrow to Orlando, Hong Kong, Shanghai, New York and Los Angeles from the 20th July 2020.

Virgin's first planned flights will be to Orlando and Hong Kong - however, they are monitoring external conditions extremely closely, in particular the travel restrictions many

countries have in place including the 14-day quarantine policy for travellers entering the UK.
